The provisions of the 2014 edition of the NEC are hereby adopted by the Town and declared to be effective within the territorial limits of the Town immediately upon receipt by the Town and filing the same in the office of the Town Secretary.

SECTION 33. The following sections are hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 101.1. **Title**. These regulations shall be known as the *National Electric Code* of the Town of Brock, Texas.

- **SECTION 34.** In accordance with the NEC, the Town Commission further desires to adopt the local amendments recommended by the North Central Texas Council of Governments for uniformity throughout the North Texas the region. Accordingly, the "Amendments to the 2014 National Electric Code" are hereby made a part of this Article by reference. The Town adopts these amendments, all of which shall be maintained on file in the office of the Town Secretary.
- **SECTION 35.** Any violations of the terms of the Article and of said code is hereby declared to be a nuisance and shall be subject to abatement by all methods by law.
- **SECTION 36.** Any violation of the terms of this Ordinance is further declared to be a misdemeanor, and any person found to be guilty thereof shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). Each day that such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable accordingly.
- **SECTION 37**. That all provisions of the ordinances of the Town of Brock, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby, repealed, and that all other provisions of the Ordinances of the Town of Brock not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- SECTION 38. That should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this Ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part thereof decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid.

[F] **Section 903.2; delete the exception.

(Reason: The exception deletion is due to the fact that such telecom areas pose an undue fire risk to the structural integrity of the building. This also meets with local practices in the region.)

**Section 903.2.9; add Section 903.2.9.3 to read as follows:

[F] 903.2.9.3 Self-service storage facility. An automatic sprinkler system shall be installed throughout all self-service storage facilities.

(Reason: Fire departments are unable to inspect these commercial occupancies and are unaware of the contents being stored. Previous allowance to separate units by fire barriers is difficult to enforce maintenance after opening.)

Exceptions:

- 2. Occupancies in Group F-2.

903.2.11.7 High-Piled Combustible Storage. For any building with a clear height exceeding 12 feet (4572 mm), see Chapter 32 of the IFC to determine if those provisions apply.

903.2.11.8 Spray Booths and Rooms. New and existing spray booths and spraying rooms shall be protected by an approved automatic fire-extinguishing system.

903.2.11.9 Buildings Over 6,000 sq.ft. An automatic sprinkler system shall be installed throughout all buildings with a building area 6,000 sq.ft. or greater and in all existing buildings that are enlarged to be 6,000 sq. ft. or greater. For the purpose of this provision, fire walls shall not define separate buildings.

Exception: Open parking garages in compliance with Section 406.5 of the International Building Code.

(Reason: Provides jurisdictions options as to their desired level of sprinkler protection based on multiple factors including firefighting philosophies/capabilities.)

**Section 903.3.1.1.1; change to read as follows:

[F] 903.3.1.1.1 Exempt locations. When approved by the fire code official, automatic sprinklers shall not be required in the following rooms or areas where such ... {text unchanged}... because it is damp, of fireresistance-rated construction or contains electrical equipment.

- 1. Any room where the application of water, or flame and water, constitutes a serious life or fire
- 2. Any room or space where sprinklers are considered undesirable because of the nature of the contents, when approved by the code official.
- 3. Generator and transformer rooms, under the direct control of a public utility, separated from the remainder of the building by walls and floor/ceiling or roof/ceiling assemblies having a fireresistance rating of not less than 2 hours.
- 4. Rooms or areas that are of noncombustible construction with wholly noncombustible contents.
- 5. Fire service access Elevator machine rooms, and machinery spaces, and hoistways, other than pits where such sprinklers would not necessitate shunt trip requirements under any circumstances.
- {Delete.} 6.

(Reason: Gives more direction to code official. Exception 4 deleted to provide protection where fire risks are poorly addressed. Amendment 903.2 addresses Exception 5. above relative to the elimination of sprinkler protection in these areas to avoid the shunt trip requirement.)

**Section 903.3.1.2.3; add section to read as follows:

[F] Section 903.3.1.2.3 Attics and Attached Garages. Sprinkler protection is required in attic spaces of such buildings two or more stories in height, in accordance with NFPA 13 and or NFPA 13R requirements, and attached garages.

(Reason: Attic protection is required due to issues with fire exposure via soffit vents, as well as firefighter safety. Several jurisdictions indicated experience with un-protected attic fires resulting in displacement of all building occupants. NFPA 13 provides for applicable attic sprinkler protection requirements, as well as exemptions to such, based on noncombustible construction, etc. Attached garages already require sprinklers via NFPA 13R - this amendment just re-emphasizes the requirement.)
